International skills and drills *with Cynthia Horner*

Saturday, December 14th 8:30 am-12:00 pm

This workshop will focus on Jumps, Tunnels, weaves and possibly a contact. The session will work sequences to improve your international skills so that you can be more successful on any course!

Puppies Foundations *with Soshana Dos*

Saturday, December 14th 8:30 am-12:00 pm

Foundation training affects everything you do in agility throughout your dog's whole agility career. Learn the skills needed to achieve a good balance of obstacle focus and handler focus with your dog. Teach

your dog that following the handling is valuable. We will work exercises & play games that strengthen drive, build confidence and develop teamwork.

Mind Games with Cynthia Horner

Saturday, December 14th 1:00 pm - 4:30 pm

This workshop uses jumps and tunnels to help you mentally prepare for anything unexpected on course! - It will help you be able to recover when things go wrong to still do your best. Being able to "think on your feet" helps with any course but also helps you be more successful in snooker.

Young Dogs with Soshana Dos

Saturday, December 14th 1:00 pm - 4:30 pm

Appropriate for young dogs just starting to sequence, as well as teams wanting to work on basic skills. Ensure that your dog is following your handling, paying attention to acceleration/deceleration and that he understands how to listen at speed! We will be learning and testing some handling and listening skills in shorter jump/tunnel sequences.

Those Critical Spots! with Cynthia Horner

Sunday, December 15th 8:30 am-12:00 pm

Getting to critical spots on course. This workshop will use jumps, tunnels and weaves. It will help you build commitment, verbals (as well as your timing) to help you be able to get to where you need to be on any course.

Where to Look with Soshana Dos

Sunday, December 15th 8:30 am-12:00 pm

Being connected to your teammate is imperative to success in agility, but while the concept may be simple, putting it into practice is not! In this workshop you will learn when and where you should be looking and why it matters.

Novice/Open Handling with Cynthia Horner

Sunday, December 15th 1:00 pm - 4:30 pm

This session will focus on jumps and tunnels in short sequences. The workshop will show how to improve your dog's commitment, and your handling techniques to give clear cues to your dog.

Clean Runs with Soshana Dos

Sunday, December 15th 1:00 pm - 4:30 pm

Do you suffer from a case of JOFT (just one f*ing thing)? Do you feel like you and your dogs have great skills but just can't seem to put it all together? In this workshop learn techniques to help you and your dog put it all together.

Cynthia Hornor

Cynthia Hornor has been competing in Agility since 1997. She has put several Championships on multiple dogs in USDAA, AKC and UKI. She has been a 20-time National finalist in AKC, USDAA and UKI National events



with five different dogs. She is a multi time World team member for WAO, IFCS and EO, USA Team. She has won International medals twice and has been a multi-time National Champion - winning AKC Nationals in the 12, 16 and 24C Divisions. She has won every event at both the US Open and Cynosports. She is a consistent podium representative at many National and Regional events. Most recently Cynthia's mix, Nimble, "won" a class at the European Open in Denmark in 2023.

Worth noting and more importantly, many of Cynthia's students have been National and Regional Finalists themselves!

Soshana Dos

Soshana loves teaching Agility and is skilled at effectively communicating complex handling maneuvers as well as explaining the theory and fundamentals behind the handling method. She wants to be sure her



students understand the Why as well as the How of everything they do.
